2nd IAMD CoE Annual Conference Administrative Details

1. **Schedule:** The conference will be conducted over two days, from Tuesday 13th to Wednesday 14th of June 2023. It is advised to use Monday 12th of June 2023 (or earlier) for travelling and in processing and Thursday 14th of June 2023 (or later) as travel day. The projected schedule of the conference will be updated regularly on the IAMD CoE web page <u>https://iamd-coe.org/</u> A provisional agenda of the conference is as per Enclosure 1, while a final detailed Agenda will be issued along with the joining instructions, ten days before the event.

2. **Participants:** Registration is open to all interested participants. We anticipate for participation from NATO, Partner Nations, Military and International Organizations, Non-Governmental Organizations, CoEs, Academia and Defence Industry as well as the broader IAMD Community of Interest. Please feel free to disseminate this invitation to persons that you deem relevant and interested to attend.

3. **Classification:** The conference has no classification marking and all contents will be releasable to public. The conference will be held under the **Chatham House Rule.**

4. **Attire:** The attire for the Ice Braker event will be Civilian attire casual (jacket-no tie). The attire for the Conference (13th & 14th June) will be summer service uniform (NATO Class A) for the speakers, working dress (NATO Class B- short sleeved shirt, open neck) for the military personnel and Civilian attire casual (jacket or shirt-no tie) for the civilians.
