SUBJECT: "AI-Empowered Drone Detection Passive Radar Using 5G Signals" Project

- Intended Contract with FORTH-ICS

(a) Shared Budget 2023 - Transfer of funds between/within Chapters (b) Procurement procedure (tender requirements in case of prospective

contracting with FORTH-ICS)

PURPOSE: SC to approve budget and procurement requirements in the context of con-

tracting the project "AI-Empowered Drone Detection Passive Radar Using

5G Signals".

BACKGROUND: Based on pre-solicitation conferences with the Foundation for Research

and Technology - Hellas/Institute of Computer Science (FORTH-ICS), the intended research project of creating prototype system of artificial intelligence-empowered drone detection passive radar using 5G signals has the

following main characteristics:

a. Duration: 24 months (2 phases x 12 months);

b. Expected deliverables of 1<sup>st</sup> phase: (a) Technical report with full details of system's architecture, specifications & requirements, and (b) Technical report with system's performance evaluation on simulated 5G signals and

estimated performance in real environments;

c. Expected deliverables of 2<sup>nd</sup> phase: (a) Technical report of final prototype system, (b) Technical report with system's performance evaluation on real

data, and (c) Prototype system;

d. Total budget: 79.000 €.

ANALYSIS & STATUS:

In order to initiate the procurement process of this project, the Centre has explored the potential capabilities of funding through the current budget, striving to avoid any burden, if possible, of the budgets of the following years while remaining within the figures of the Medium-Term Financial Plan.

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Furthermore, taken into account the estimated amount of the project, bidding and award procedures as set in Annex F of FAPs have been considered as follows:

- " 4.2.1.4 Goods and services of which the cost is estimated to exceed the equivalent of Level C of the EFL (30.000,00 €) but below Level D of the EFL (139.000 €) shall be procured through soliciting from at least five (5) economic operators/suppliers known to meet the technical and commercial standards.
- 5. Deviations from the above requirements may only be authorized by the Director in the interests of security, urgency, standardization of equipment, or/and exceptional circumstances. When the total amount exceeds the equivalent of Level C of the EFL (30.000,00 €) annually, such cases shall be reported to the SC for decision (as paragraph 3.4.1.3)."

Given the special technical specifications and the specific nature of the intended project, a deviation from bidding-award procedure which refers to the minimum number (5) of bidders needed to participate in the tender process is required, in order to have a fruitful tender process in case of a unique bid.

After detailed monitoring of the current budget execution, it is estimated that it is possible to finance the entire value (79.000 €) of the whole project from the approved Shared Budget of FY 2023:

- a. Within the limits of the approved funds (256.000 €) through internal transfers of appropriations, without any need for additional contributions.
- b. Without raising any issues of meeting the requirements of other activities of the Centre for the current year.

To this end, reallocation of funds between/within Chapters of Shared Budget 2023 is recommended as Annex A (according to the provisions of FAPs, par. 19.1 - under SC approval).

In addition, in order to achieve a fruitful tender process, it is considered necessary to adopt a deviation from the procurement procedures, allowing the award in case of a single bid, since it is likely that the minimum number (5) of tenders required under the established rules will not be reached following the market survey already carried out.

FINANCIAL
CONSIDERATIONS
& FUNDING:

Upon the approval of the proposed transfers of appropriations within the Shared Budget 2023, the entire project will be funded without any need for additional funding in the following years.

Moreover, taking into consideration that this is a multi-year project and its deliverables are expected by the end of the coming two (2) years (2024 and 2025), the funds which will be committed from the current Shared Budget (79.000 €) are to be reported to be carried-forward (according to the provisions of FAPs, par. 17.5).

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### & DECISION:

**RECOMMENDATIONS** The SC members are requested to unanimously approve (in accordance with the provisions of par. 4.3 of Operational MOU):

- a. The proposed internal transfers of appropriations as Annex A within the Shared Budget of Fiscal Year 2023.
- b. By way of exception, the deviation from rules regarding the procurement process required for this project, allowing the award without a minimum number of bids.
