1.6 The following:

- 1.6.5 Cost-effective and efficient contracting: Assurance has been provided that the prospective contractor complies with the procurement terms and conditions, delivering the most cost-effective and efficient solution to meet the specific needs of the Centre.

- 1.7.1 Is in complete conformity with the bidding terms and instructions, general and special provisions, and the technical specifications established in the respective IFB, having submitted all requisite documentation;
