SUBJECT: **Job Descriptions' Insertion of DS Branch personnel**

PURPOSE: To inform the SC about the amendment of six (6) Job Descriptions of DS Branch personnel and decide/approve accordingly.

BACKGROUND: This is the fourth revision of the DS Branch JDs. The previous one (3rd) was made according to the last SC decision about the minimum of 15 travel days per year on temporary duty funded by the nations. The proposed amendments aim to ensure that all DS personnel will be able to support the IAMD COE in the full range of DS activities.

ANALYSIS & STATUS: Main drivers for the specific amendments in the DS JDs are the following:

a. As far as the COE is more and more involved in doctrine development (already member of 3 writing teams and able to join others in the future), it is essential for the branch Head to know and master the NATO doctrine development process perfectly in order to guide the work of the Centre's SMEs in this area.

b. As an IAMD hub of expertise, the Centre and more specifically DS SMEs are not only focusing on Air operations but also on Joint operations, considering the new operational domains (Space and Cyberspace) according to the latest NATO directives and concepts.

Based on the above, IAMD COE has prepared and submitted as enclosures the JDs of the following table, along with remarks/justification on the scope/reason for the amendment.
