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1.1 The current Statement of Work (SOW) covers the general requirements and technical specifications that shall be covered by the Contractor for the items requested.

2. General Requirements

2.1 All items/equipment shall be brand new.

2.2 All components must be assembled, connected, and thoroughly tested prior to its deployment within the new IAMD COE premises. Equipment installation and software configuration, along with the associated staff training, shall be carried out exclusively and mandatorily by the Contractor. The Smart Key Holder Cabinet shall be delivered and installed within the new IAMD COE premises whenever requested by the IAMD COE, in a fully operational condition and accompanied by all manuals and the original packaging (where applicable), following timely notification to the Contractor.

3. Technical Requirements/Specifications - Deliverables**3.1 Smart Key Holder Cabinet:**

3.1.1 Requested quantity: One (1) Smart Key Holder Cabinet.

3.1.2 Technical specifications (minimum):

3.1.2.1 RFID technology for identifying each key box;

3.1.2.2 Electronically and automatically locking door;

3.1.2.3 32-compartment cabinet for storing corresponding sets of keys;

3.1.2.4 Modular expansion option if the system's capacity needs to be increased in the future by adding new cabinets;

3.1.2.5 RFID key fob with security ring (seal that is destroyed to remove the key);

3.1.2.6 Key holder resistant to adverse conditions with lifetime warranty;

3.1.2.7 The key holder does not require a battery for use (passive RFID);

3.1.2.8 Key holders with built-in RFID reader for automatic key recognition;

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3.1.2.9 Key holders with built-in indicator light to show the user which keys they have access to;

3.1.2.10 Cabinet terminal with built-in RFID card reader for user card recognition and keyboard for PIN code entry;

3.1.2.11 The terminal's card reader must support MIFARE 13.56MHz RFID cards

3.1.2.12 Terminal with built-in 125KHz card reader for quick key return (ability to read the RFID of the key fob/key ring directly);

3.1.2.13 Cabinet terminal with screen for displaying instructions to the use;

3.1.2.14 Key retrieval option either with RFID card, PIN, or both;

3.1.2.15 Built-in backup battery & UPS uninterruptible power supply system in case of power failure;

3.1.2.16 Including software suite for managing rights, users, keys, and usage reports must be provided;

3.1.2.17 The management software should be provided as a web application and support network access from any PC terminal;

3.1.2.18 Possibility of future software upgrades for increased security: key retrieval only with the confirmed presence of 2 or 3 people;

3.1.2.19 Possibility of future software upgrades for increased security: restriction of key retrieval based on time (time profiles);

3.1.2.20 Possibility of future software upgrades to support integration with 3rd party systems or databases via web services;

3.1.2.21 The equipment must be accompanied by a CE declaration of conformity;

3.1.2.22 The country of origin of the equipment must be within the European Union or the USA;

4. **Warranty**

4.1 The items/equipment requested shall have one (1) year (minimum) warranty, from the date of the purchase for operating conditions and use based on the official instructions of the manufacturer.

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5.1 Under the Contractor's responsibility, the requested equipment shall be delivered to the IAMD COE premises (Greece, Chania, Akrotiri, Souda Air Base, 73100 - Camp 115 Combat Wing) without any additional charges for the Centre. Any delivery - shipping charges should be incorporated in the price proposal and shall be covered by the Contractor.

6. Delivery Time - Deadline

6.1 The requested items shall be delivered by 19 December 2025.

6.2 If the Contractor fails to deliver the requested items within the time specified above, he may pay the IAMD COE (after a documented decision of the Director) liquidated damages of the respective supply following the provisions and considering any exemptions according to the Articles 206 and 207 of Hellenic Law No 4412/2016, and par. 14 of Part II of this IFB.
